

Minutes of the Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting for Crook and Winstar, held by ZOOM on Tuesday 11th May 2021 at 7.30pm.

The Chairman of Crook and Winstar Parish Council, Councillor Richard Metcalfe, welcomed everyone to the meeting.

There was an attendance of 9, including most of the Parish Councillors, County Councillor Jim Bland, District Councillors Pat Bell and Hazel Hodgson, and Parish Clerk Kevin Price. Apologies were received from the Revd. Michael Woodcock (who had sent a report and this will be circulated to all Councillors).

Minutes:

The minutes of the 2019 Assembly Meeting, held on 23rd May 2019 were taken as read. There were no matters arising.

Chairman's Report:

The Chairman read his report, which was very comprehensive and referred to the particular difficulties during the year due to the coronavirus pandemic and all meetings being held by ZOOM. The roads in the parish are in a very poor condition and, despite many reports being made, nothing seems to be done. The Council has commented upon a number of planning applications and has held site meetings when required. Councillor Mike Poynter retired after 11 years as a Parish Councillor - we are sorry to see him go, but thank him for his years of service and wish him well. The Council assisted in the improvements to the churchyard car park and saved the PCC a significant sum. The Chairman thanked all the Parish Councillors, County and District Councillors, and the Clerk for their work.

District Councillor's Report:

Councillor Bell said it had been a hectic year due to the pandemic and many SLDC staff were still working from home.

Councillor Hodgson said the new 'Customer Connect' was working well, and 'My Account' can be used by all residents to access all the Council's services. The Locality Officers are now in place and should be contacting Parish Councils soon. There is also further funding available from today for green projects.
